Le Barthélemy Hotel & Spa, St-Barthélemy

The tiny French-speaking Caribbean island of <u>St-Barthélemy</u> opened to American visitors in late June (with some requirements, including a negative COVID-19 test from 72 hours prior to arrival), and one of its most celebrated hotels reopens on October 28. The breezy, beachfront Le Barthélemy's <u>Océan</u> <u>Lux Piscine Privée suites</u> have glass doors that slide open to heated plunge pools and panoramic ocean views.
